INTRODUCTION

Stratagene's Glogos® II autorad markers are luminescent peel-off stickers used for accurately marking and aligning autoradiographs. Easily affixed to plastic wrap or paper, these convenient markers emit low-level luminescence rather than radioactivity, making the Glogos II autorad markers a safe, nonhazardous alternative to radioactive ink. The asymmetric design of the Glogos II autorad markers ensures accurate orientation of an autoradiograph to its membrane. To assist in the alignment of a blot or membrane to its autoradiograph, a ruler is included with the markers. The Glogos II autorad markers are adaptable for long or short exposures, and their usage range is from -70° C to room temperature.

INSTRUCTIONS

After probing, washing, and wrapping the membrane, peel off a Glogos II autorad marker and affix the marker to the wrapping in a place where the marker will not cover the data. Expose and develop the film as usual and then align the image on the film with the Glogos II autorad marker to achieve correct orientation.

Extent of Light Activation

The Glogos II autorad markers are calibrated, so exposure to ambient levels of room light for at least 1 minute will provide sufficient activation for autoradiograph exposures lasting longer than ~45 minutes. Because most light decay occurs within the first hour, a Glogos II autorad marker exposed for 1 hour or for several days will appear similar.

If exposing data to film for a short period of time (e.g., 15 minutes) or for quick exposures, hold the Glogos II autorad marker close to a bright light for just a few seconds to activate the marker.

Decay

Because luminescence decays rapidly and to avoid light-colored images, put the Glogos II autorad marker on film within 3 minutes after placing the marker in the dark following light activation.

Exposure to Film

Place the Glogos II autorad marker directly facing the film. If superactivated with *bright* light, minimize the movement of the Glogos II autorad marker once the marker is adjacent to the film to avoid double exposures. Sharper images are obtained when the marker is affixed to clear areas of the wrapping, rather than against a background of white, reflective material (e.g., Whatman® 3MM paper). If *extreme* accuracy in autoradiograph alignment is required and/or if data is large in size, use two Glogos II autorad markers, placing one on each side of the longest diagonal.

Temperature

The Glogos II autorad markers are effective for exposures ranging from room temperature to -70 °C.

Intensifying Screen

The use of an intensifying screen will increase the intensity of the image by two- to threefold, but will *slightly* decrease the resolution of the image.
